I understand that as a member of U.S.Horse Rescue's family of volunteers I am obligated to do my best to keep myself, my coworker and the horses safe and that I understand that this volunteer position requires commitment. Despite the fact that there is no pay attached to this position it is still a job and I understand that the rescue and the horses need me to be committed to show up for my shifts regardless of weather, etc. I further understand that if I am a proficient rider I may be granted the privilege of riding horse/pony at certain times to help exercise them but that there is no guarantee and it depends entirely on staffing to supervise the riders, the availability and health of the various horses and the weather.
